The Board ensures that AJRCCC maintains a safe and sanitary environment while providing quality care and services to residents of the facility and as ordered by each resident's physician.

Results

Residents moved into the new AJRCCC on June 12, 2013. The three (3) State Ombudsmen were on site following the move and were satisfied with the successful move of residents.

The Physical Therapy staff are now on-site in the new AJRCCC to help the residents.

The VA Survey Team inspected the operations of the new AJRCCC to consider entering a contract relationship that would allow us to care of the veterans who are in need of nursing home services.

Future Goals

The AJRCCC Board requested Management to research how we can start hiring Trainee's or Certified Nursing Assistant's upon graduation with the intent of hiring more enrolled Oneida Tribal members for our Nursing Home.

The AJRCCC Board requested Management to place communication tool or guide of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) relating to our Nursing Home policies, admitting policies and rules, etc.
