

## STIPULATION AND ORDER FOR DISMISSAL

NOW COMES the Plaintiff, Oneida Small Business, Inc., by its Attorney Andrew A. Van Sickle, and Defendants, Scott D. Cottrell and Colleen M. Cottrell, with the following Stipulation:

The parties stipulate and agree that this action is dismissed without prejudice upon condition of defendants, Scott D. Cottrell and Colleen M. Cottrell, pay to plaintiff the sum of \$116,032.86 as follows: by a voluntary wage assignment or automatic ACH payments to Plaintiff, Oneida Small Business, Inc., in the sum of \$350.00 per month to be paid monthly commencing March 5, 2014, and the on the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month thereafter until paid in full.

Defendants, Scott D. Cottrell and Colleen M. Cottrell also agree to pay/assign Plaintiff, Oneida Small Business, Inc., their annual Oneida Tribe per capita payment from the Oneida Tribe which is paid on a yearly basis from the Oneida Tribe in or around September of each year. Said per capita payment shall commence with the 2014 annual payment and every year thereafter until the entire debt is paid in full.



IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in the event defendants, Scott D. Cottrell and Colleen Cottrell, fail to make any payment when due and in the amount due, the Court shall, upon receiving notice in the form of a sworn affidavit thereof from plaintiff's attorney enter judgment, *ex parte*, without the need or requirement of an evidentiary hearing against defendant in the amount of the then remaining unpaid balance without further notice or hearing.
