The court convened a scheduling conference to inquire into the status of the case.

Mr. Swanson reported that the debtor is in the process of putting its plan together, has basic terms in place, has been negotiating with creditors, and working with investment bankers. Mr. Swanson stated that the debtor needed an extension of the exclusivity periods and would be filing a motion shortly.

None of the parties offered an oral objection to a brief extension of the exclusivity periods, but Ms. McKinnon, Ms. Ogden, and Mr. Thill expressed concern about any further extensions.

Ms. Ginsberg took issue with the lack of historical financial information in the debtor's statement of financial affairs. Mr. Swanson explained that the debtor was still in the process of retrieving its records from the Brown County Sheriff and United States Attorney. Mr. Swanson stated that the debtor was making a good faith effort to comply with the requirements of the Code and would supplement the record if need be should additional information become available.

The court inquired whether it made sense to set a claims bar date. Mr. Swanson requested that the court give the debtor additional time to retrieve its records before setting a claims bar date.

Based on the forthcoming motion to extend the exclusivity periods, *see* 11 U.S.C. § 1121(c)(2) & (3), the court adjourned the scheduling conference to **August 31, 2016, at 3 p.m. via telephone**.
