The Court inquires if all parties are in agreement with the adjournment.

AUSA Johnson states they did not object to the initial 60 day delay, which would have put the trial in September. AUSA Johnson expresses his concern with moving the case to October as the case was indicted in July, 2016. AUSA Johnson agrees to the October trial date if that is the end of the delays.

Attorney Porter agrees with October trial date.

Attorney LeBell agrees with October trial date.

The Court adjourns the trial to **October 23, 2017 at 8:30 a.m.** The parties estimate the trial to take one week, or less. The final pretrial is set for **October 6, 2017 at 1:30 p.m.** Motions in limine are due **September 15, 2017**, responses due on or before **September 22, 2017**. Jury instructions, proposed verdicts, and witness lists are due by **September 29, 2017**. Pretrial motions are due **June 19, 2017**, responses due **July 14, 2017**, and replies due **July 25, 2017**.

The Court excludes time under the Speedy Trial Act. The Court notes that the case has already been designated complex. The Court finds that counsel needs additional time to review necessary materials for trial.
