- OSGC has partnered in a 120,000 square foot building under construction in the Oneida Industrial Park that will house the Badger Sheet Metal Company. This \$6-million project can mean numerous jobs for Oneida Tribal members. The management of Badger Sheet Metal plans a recruiting effort that includes job training.

OBJECTIVES

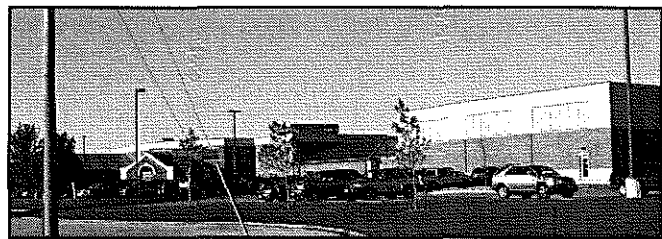
A. Economic development through diversification.

- The Oneida Seven Generations Corporation has developed the Packerland Industrial Park, a 160-acre site along Packerland Drive, immediately west of the Ashwaubenon Industrial Park. Leasing of five acres tracts or more of is being marketed to major industrial or office tenants and is a free trade zone. The OSGC seeks to bring solid economic development to the Oneida Reservation, that will create jobs, help our economy, and contribute to well being of the Nation overall.

HIGHLIGHTS

- OSGC has undertaken a partnership with Management Enterprises to form Babcock I, a limited liability corporation. Babcock I constructed the 50,000 square foot health facility leased to Bellin Health Systems and recently expanded the structure by 62,000 square feet. The facility is a clinic and therapy center that specializes in sports rehabilitation. OSGC, as Babcock I and its partners are constructing a 32,000 square foot Oncology Center on the site just east of the original building. The new facility of Oncologists dedicated to treating cancer patients at all levels of treatment. Oneida citizens can benefit by having this facility within our community. OSGC maintains 51% ownership in this project without investing any additional dollars into the existing structures. This has been an outstanding investment for the corporation and its stockholders.
