Petition for Action on Conditions of Pretrial Release

COMES NOW, Janitza Gomez, U.S. Pretrial Services Officer, presenting an official report upon the conduct of Troy Wragg, who was placed under pretrial release supervision by the Honorable Lynne A. Sitarski sitting in the Court at Philadelphia, on September 17, 2015, under the following conditions:

1. Report as directed to Pretrial Services
2. Drug testing/treatment
3. Surrender/Do not obtain a passport
4. Travel restricted to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and the Northern District of Georgia, unless prior permission is granted by Pretrial Services
5. Surrender/Do not obtain firearms
6. No contact with codefendants, potential witnesses, or other involved in criminal activity
7. Seek/Maintain Employment
8. Maintain residence at 6520 Joe Frank Harris Parkway, Adairsville, GA. If defendant wants to change his address, the defendant must secure permission from Pretrial Services in advance

On June 28, 2016, Your Honor modified the defendant's conditions of release to include mental health treatment under the direction and guidance of Pretrial Services.

Respectfully presenting petition for action of Court and for cause as follows:

The defendant was originally arrested in the Northern District of Georgia, and was living at the above mentioned address until he relocated to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania in June 2016.

On November 22, 2017, the defendant advised Pretrial Services he moved in with his girlfriend, Megan Hallett, at 200 Creek Village Drive, Apartment E, Elkton, MD 21921, due to financial issues and his inability to pay his portion of the rent. Mr. Wragg reported he continues to search for employment in sales or telemarketing, however, his medical condition, seizures, is creating some obstacles.

As the defendant no longer resides in Georgia, Pretrial Services is requesting the original travel restrictions, Northern District of Georgia, be removed and modified to include the District of Maryland and Eastern District of Pennsylvania, unless prior permission is granted in advance by Pretrial Services.


In addition, Pretrial Services is requesting the defendant's court-ordered residence condition, maintain residence at 6520 Joe Frank Harris Parkway, Adairsville, GA, be amended to allow Mr. Wragg to reside at an address approved by Pretrial Services.

AUSA Robert Livermore and Defense Counsel, Joseph Mancano, were provided a copy of this petition.


