When the FBI scooped into the offices of Oneida Housing authority Thursday, June 26, 2014, to confiscate the computers, it was big news around SITE I and for the Tribe. It is always big news when the FBI comes to town. How did this happen? The Oneida Business Committee Based on potential criminality in a recent audit by the Tribe's Internal Audit Department, turned over documents that have been percolating since the Dale Wheelock Scandal, Fired in 2011, when theft was found in a limited scope investigation when he was Director of Housing. The investigation came about when Whitney Wheelock, OHA employee, exposed theft and reported it to Shane John, supervisor, who promptly fired Wheelock. Ultimately, the testimony by Dayle Wheelock's son, Whitney, sparked an investigation into missing Federal Energy Grant monies. That investigation by outsider Sonny Martin and Internal Audit generated other problems that needed further audits and investigation. Greg Matson worked as a project manager for Dayle Wheelock and a preliminary investigation

showed doubling billing by Matson and mismanaged funds co-mingling Tribal and Federal Funds. As more audits and investigations ensued, Jay FUSS, resigned quickly after being confronted with the finding that he, Construction Manager for OHA, was taking Housing/Tribal/Federal inventory and using it in his side business to sell those supplies. Some of that inventory found its way into the houses of Joanne House, Chief Legal Counsel, and Kurt Jordan, Assistant Director at Land Management, among others.

Currently, the FBI is investigating documents from Land Management, Land Commission, and Oneida Housing Authority Construction.

There are many names being looked at by the FBI, and one of them is the PATHFINDER, Greg Matson, who speaks only and often of the GOOD MIND, and the FBI will certainly take advantage of the fact that Greg Matson seeks to
