The OBC appreciates and values the concern, interest, and feedback received from Tribal members and encourage continued interest and participation.

MOVING FORWARD

Action taken by GTC on October 26, 2014 will guide how to fill future vacancies by amending the Election Law. The OBC directed the Legislative Operating Committee to draft amendments to the Election Law which address filling future vacancies. Tribal members will be notified when opportunities arise to provide input.

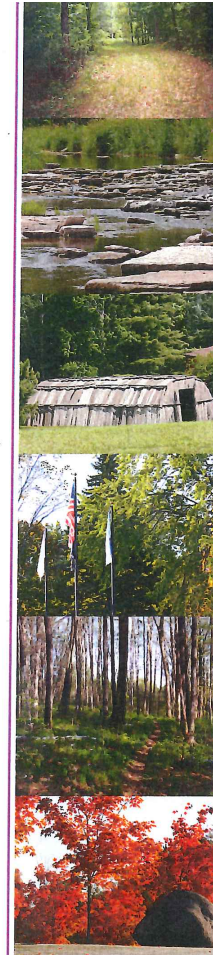

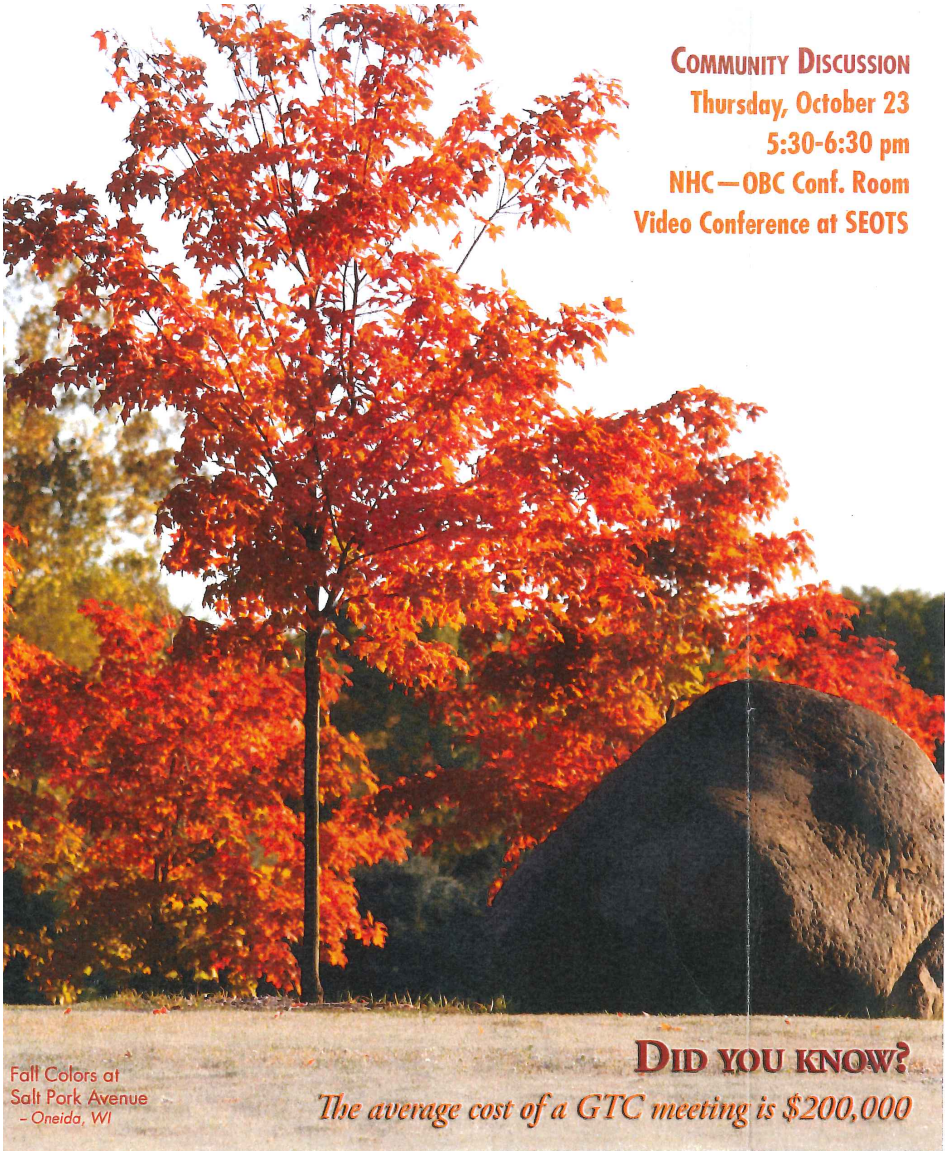
