INCIDENT - FRIDAY, February 19, 2016

I had heard United States Senator Tammy Baldwin was supposed to be in Oneida, Wisconsin at 1:45 PM on Friday, February 19, 2016.

The following is my recollection of the events that occurred on Friday, February 19, 2016:

I invited Oneida Tribal elder Lou Ann Green to go with me to see United States Senator Tammy Baldwin at the Norbert Hill Center, located at N7210 Seminary Road, in Oneida, Wisconsin.

I picked Lou Ann Green up at 1:00 PM.

When I got to the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room located on the second floor of the Norbert Hill Center where the Oneida Business Committee Member offices are situated, I talked with Loretta Metoxen, Oneida tribal historian, and Troy Parr (a relative of his was friend of mine), Assistant Division Director for Development.

The following other tribal members (from our community) were in the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room when United States Senator Tammy Baldwin's entourage arrived:

- Michael Debraska
- Cathy L. Metoxen
- Leah Dodge
- Bradley Graham
- Lou Ann Green and her sister
- · Several other Oneidas

Some of the employees present in the in the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room when United States Senator Tammy Baldwin's entourage arrived:

- Dr. Vir Oneida Community Health Center
- Norbert Hill, Jr. Oneida Higher Education Department

When the program started, Nathan King was MCing the function. I was never asked to leave and I was never told to leave for any reason at any point in time before the event/function started. There was never any announcement made at any point in time before, during or after the event/function that it was a "closed meeting".

Loretta Metoxen gave her 5 minute presentation on Oneida History.

Troy Parr gave his presentation on Development and our land. He did a slide show on the big screen.

Norbert Hill, Jr. gave his presentation on education, the lower grades and higher education.

Dr. Vir gave a report on the Oneida Health Center.

There was a photo opportunity after Dr. Vir's report concluded. The Oneida Business Committee Members then stood up front with United States Senator Tammy Baldwin for a photo opportunity.

The following Oneida Business Committee Members participated:

- Melinda Danforth Tribal Vice Chairwoman
- Fawn Billie Oneida Business Committee Member
- David Jordan Oneida Business Committee Member
- Brandon Yellowbird-Stevens Oneida Business Committee Member
- Ron "Tehassi" Hill, Jr Oneida Business Committee Member

NOTE: Oneida Tribal Chairwoman Tina Danforth was not there.

During this time, Oneida Tribal Vice-Chairwoman Melinda Danforth presented a small ornate gift box with strawberries to United States Senator Tammy Baldwin.

I wanted to talk to her about the illegal constitutional changes that the BIA made in our Oneida Constitution. The change in amendment C took away the right of future Oneida Tribal soldiers to vote by absentee ballot in the next change of the constitution if they were fighting in a foreign war. If

anyone were trying to change the membership rules that would eliminate them as a tribal member they wouldn't be able to vote.

I wanted to talk to her about the importance of our American Civil Rights and that she needed to do something to restore those rights to our Indian people.

I also wanted to talk to her about the corruption occurring in our tribe, the Oneida Tribe's failure to prosecute the criminals, and the federal connections.

It seemed like all the presentations were done, so I stood up and I said to United States Senator Tammy Baldwin "I am not one of the elite, I am just a 74 year old Oneida Tribal Member and I am very concerned about the direction our Tribe is taking. I fear that they are going to take away our freedom of religion and other American Civil Rights in the future because of the change that was made in our constitution.

I asked to speak. United States Senator Tammy Baldwin said I could speak after the children's smoke dance performance.

I sat down then because I was anticipating that the smoke dancers would be doing their performance then.

In about a minute or two, there were three (3) Oneida Police Officers came to my side. They told me I had to leave the room.

I said "Senator Tammy Baldwin said I could speak later. I'm not leaving the room."

The Oneida Police Officers repeated their demand, which was for me to leave the room.

Then one of the Oneida Police Officers said "If you don't leave the room, then we're going to carry you out!"

I thought to myself my freedom of speech and freedom of assembly is being taken away from me – My American Civil Rights. I said "I'm not leaving the room."

The Oneida Police Officers said "Then we will carry you out.

And I said to the Oneida Police Officers "Well I guess you're going to have to carry me out, because I am not leaving the room."

Then one Oneida Police Officers got on each side of me, the female Oneida Police Officers grabbed my arms and they took me to the ground. The two female Oneida Police Officers took hold of me by my arms/wrists and the other Oneida Police Officer took hold of me by my ankles/feet and carried me out.

The Oneida Police Officers carried me from the front row where I was seated on the right side of the room, past the children out of the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room, through the meeting room doors and set me on the cold concrete floor out in the hall way just outside the doors to the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room.

While I was on the floor, Oneida elder Lou Ann Green came out to see if I was okay.

The Oneida Police Officers told me I had to get up and go stand by the wall. The wall straight across from the doors of the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room, located in the Oneida Business Committee offices hallway. At this point in time, there were two (2) male Oneida Police Officers and two (2) female Oneida Police Officers in the area where I was being detained.

I asked the Oneida Police Officers for their names and badge numbers. They would not say their names and badge numbers.

When I was standing on the wall, I stepped forward to try to look at the little metal tag that stuck on the outside of their pockets. The metal tag only had the Oneida Police Officers first initials and their last names. I told Lou Ann Green what the little metal tags had on them and Lou Ann Green wrote the information down for me.

The Oneida Police Officers then shut and locked the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room doors.

Then one of the female Oneida Police Officers started trying to engage me in debate. Lou Ann Green said to the female Oneida Police Officer "do not talk to her (Madelyn)" – meaning the female Oneida Police Officer not to talk to me. She told her this four (4) times.

It was clear the female Oneida Police Officer was trying to antagonize me.

The Oneida Police Officers said "If people come through the hallway, do not holler because if you do that would be disorderly conduct and we'll have to arrest you!"

I responded "I hadn't hollered at all, why would I do that now?"

The Oneida Police Officers ignored me.

They moved me to the closed in area located by the office door of Oneida Business Committee Member Brandon Yellowbird-Stevens, where I was out of sight of the people coming out of the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room.

The people who attended the event/function with United States Senator Tammy Baldwin, other Wisconsin State Representative, and representatives from Washington, D.C., could not see me and I could not see them, as they exited the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room and went down the stairwell located just outside the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room doors.

Lou Ann Green came out of the event/function with her sister. The Oneida Police Officers must have allowed Lou Ann Green to go back into the event prior to them closing and locking the doors to the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room earlier.

While I was standing in the closed in area by Oneida Business Committee Member Brandon Yellowbird-Stevens office door – where the Oneida Police Officers were detaining me, Lou Ann Green and her sister saw me with the Oneida Police Officers.

The Oneida Police Officers were always with me from the time they took me out of my chair (located in the front of the Oneida Business Committee

Conference Room) in front of everyone, put me on the floor, grabbed me by my arms/wrists and the other Oneida Police Officer took me by my ankles/feet, and then carried me from the front row where I was seated, past the children to the back of the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room, through the meeting room doors and set me on the cold concrete floor out in the hall way just outside the doors to the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room.

Leah Dodge asked the Oneida Police Officers who had given the order to have me removed from the room. The Oneida Police Officers stated it would be in the police report.

After most of the people left, the Oneida Police Officers let me go back in the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room. Most of the people were gone out of the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room, except United States Senator Tammy Baldwin, North Eastern WI Regional Representative Jennifer Garner, and the Oneida Business Committee Members – they were all sitting in the Oneida Business Committee seats located at the front of the big desk with microphones located at the front of the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room.

As soon as I came in Oneida Business Committee Conference Room and approached the front of the room, all of the Oneida Business Committee Members left the room. Not one single one of the Oneida Business Committee Members said a word to me. Not one word. Not one single apology.

Then United States Senator Tammy Baldwin and North Eastern WI Regional Representative Jennifer Garner, the lady that staffs the Green Bay Office, came down from the Oneida Business Committee seats and sat down with me in the front row of the audience section.

I had developed a letter that morning (02/19/2016) that I presented to United States Senator Tammy Baldwin, along with supporting documents about my concerns.

United States Senator Tammy Baldwin read the letter right away. It was a one page letter.

United States Senator Tammy Baldwin expressed regret at what she had witnessed.

I asked for her assistance to restore American Civil Rights for American Indians.

And I expressed my concern about corruption in the Oneida Tribe.

I expressed my concern about my belief that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) had allowed our Oneida Constitution to be changed illegally.

I spent maybe 10 minutes with United States Senator Tammy Baldwin and North Eastern WI Regional Representative Jennifer Garner.

I expressed my regret that after what my brother, Vernon W. Cornelius, went through in the chosen Reservoir with the Marines in Korea to protect American Civil Rights, that the United States government would allow our American Civil Rights to be violated.

I reported that other Tribes were losing their Civil Rights. I requested her help to restore Civil Rights to American Indians.

Then United States Senator Tammy Baldwin left because she had another commitment she had to go to.

North Eastern WI Regional Representative Jennifer Garner stayed with me and we talked another 10 minutes.

North Eastern WI Regional Representative Jennifer Garner walked out of the Norbert Hill Center with me.

There are pictures and video footage of this horrendous act and violation of my rights.

I am going to have the Waupaca Police come and verify that this activity is taking place on my home phone.

I had difficulty filing my request for a copy of the Oneida Police Department Police Report on Saturday, February 20, 2016, regarding this incident. Oneida Police Department employee Britney Smith originally refused to provide a copy of the Oneida Police Department Report Request Form with a date received and the person who received it stated on the form. She did not provide her name until I requested it. She refused put the date and her name on the Oneida Police Department Report Request Form until I told her I would report her to a higher official if she did not include it on my copy.

The purpose for requesting the Oneida Police Department Report Request Form to have the date received and the person who received it on the document and on my copy was so I had proof it was submitted, when it was submitted and who received it.

On my request, I requested the names and badge numbers of the Oneida Police Officers who were present during this incident. Two (2) of the Oneida Police Officers names and badge numbers were cited in the Oneida Police Report. The other two (2) Oneida Police Officers names and badge numbers were not cited. The other two (2) Oneida Police Officers were "L" Webster and Justine Mehojah.

I would like to have it noted that there is missing information and inaccurate information on the Oneida Police Report. The second female Oneida Police Officers name is not on the Police Report. Nor is the name of the fourth Oneida Police Officer who was in the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room at the time the three (3) Oneida Police Officers put me on the floor, picked me up and carried me out of the room; and while the Oneida Police Officers had me detained outside the Oneida Business Committee Conference Room.

The experience was very traumatic and what I am stating is to the best of what I can recollect that occurred. I am not going to cower from these bullies.

I felt betrayed by my tribal government, the Oneida Business Committee Members present at the time f the incident, that did not protect my tribal constitutional rights of freedom of speech and assembly. Nor did they protect my health, safety and wellbeing.

I felt betrayed by the government of the United States that would allow a tribe to remove my American Civil Rights.

I felt that my brother Vernon W. Cornelius, who went through hell in the chosen Reservoir with the Marines in Korea to protect American Civil Rights and all Indian soldiers were being betrayed because they had fought for American Civil Rights.

I felt sad that Oneida children from the elementary Turtle School were watching this happen before their eyes, and that either they would feel that when they grow up they could be an Oneida Police Officer and abuse Oneida people or that they must do what the authorities tell them they must do or the Oneida Police would come after them, and that they had no civil rights.


