Dear Oneida Tribal member,

Over the past few months, Oneida Seven Generations Corporation has strived to provide the public, both tribal and non-tribal, with accurate information about the proposed renewable energy project. While we were awaiting a Department of Energy environmental assessment of the Ashwaubenon site to be completed, we were made aware of a number of different parcels of land in other locations that might be even better suited for the project. As a result, we have decided to pursue locating the facility on a site in the City of Green Bay. This is a business decision based on several factors:

- It makes economic sense
- It is a good location
- We have a positive working relationship with the City of Green Bay

While we respectfully listened to those who did not want the facility located in Ashwaubenon, it was not a major factor in our decision. OSGC has to do what makes business sense and generates revenues for the Oneida Nation. This new site offers us the best opportunity to be successful.

The site is on the city's far northwest side in a remote area; removed from residential neighborhoods. It is surrounded by a city dump site, a dredge material dump site, several construction firms and I-43. It is also close to transmission lines, which is an important consideration. The site, which does not need rezoning, will require a conditional use permit from the City, which we are in the process of obtaining. We have had great cooperation and support from the City, and it is good to be working positively and cooperatively with an entity that understands the many benefits of a renewable energy facility.

As we move forward, we will continue to keep you informed through the Kalihwisaks.
