Maximum Penalties: Counts 1-10: 20 years; Fine \$250,000; SR: 3 year; SA: \$100; Cts 11-14: 10 yr; Fine: to be twice the amount of criminally derived property in the transaction; SR: 3 yr.; SA: \$100.
