The defendant consents to proceeding via video conference.

The Court addresses defendant's Motion for Bail Review (docket no. 139).

Mr. Roach presents government's argument for continued detention.

Probation is also recommending continued detention.

Mr. Powell presents defense argument for the defendant's release with set conditions and location monitoring.

Mr. Koehler notes Probation does not have the background information or address where the defendant would be released to.

Mr. Roach summarizes the nature of the case and revisits argument for continued detention.

The Court finds that the presumption of detention is not overcome and considers the nature of the offense, mandatory minimum sentence if defendant is found guilty, absence of defendant's close family connections and the amount of evidence in this matter.

Therefore, the Court DENIES [139] Motion for Bail Review. Detention continued.

Jury Trial is set for 10/19/2020.
