## RENEWED MOTION TO MODIFY RESTITUTION PAYMENT SCHEDULE

NOW COMES the United States of America, by its attorneys, Gregory J. Haanstad, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, and Rebecca Taibleson, Assistant United States Attorney for said district, and hereby renews its motion to this Court, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3664(k), to modify defendant Ronald Van Den Heuvel's restitution payment schedule in case numbers 17-CR-160 and 16-CR-64.

- 1. On September 22, 2022, the Government filed and served a Motion to Modify Restitution Payment Schedule in case numbers 17-CR-160 (R. 194) and 16-CR-64 (R. 269). On September 26, 2022, the Court ordered defendant to respond within ten days. 17-CR-160 (R. 194); 16-CR-64 (R. 270). It has now been 57 days, but Mr. Van Den Heuvel has not responded.
- 2. The material circumstances described in the Motion to Modify Restitution Payment Schedule have not changed. Mr. Van Den Heuvel remains out of prison, on "home confinement," and able to work. He continues to owe several million dollars in restitution to his victims across two criminal cases. He has not made any payments since June 2021 (\$25 for case 17-CR-160) and December 2021 (\$25 for case 16-CR-64).
- 3. Based upon the foregoing, and the arguments outlined in the original Motion, the United States respectfully renews its request to this Court to modify the restitution orders in both Case 1:17-cr-00160-WCG Filed 11/21/22 Page 1 of 2 Document 197

cases to require Mr. Van Den Heuvel to begin paying restitution now, on the same terms as if he were on supervised release—i.e., "not less than \$200.00 per month or 10% of his or her net earnings, whichever is greater," and "100 percent of his or her yearly federal and state tax refunds."
