Complainant, an Assistant District Attorney, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and says that:

Count 1: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Tuesday, May 12, 2020, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 2: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Wednesday, September 28, 2022, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 3: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Tuesday, November 2, 2021, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 4: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Wednesday, May 11, 2022, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 5: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Tuesday, October 24, 2023, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 6: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Friday, November 24, 2023, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 7: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Sunday, December 24, 2023, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 8: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Wednesday, January 24, 2024, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 9: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, February 24, 2024, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case

2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Count 10: FELONY BAIL JUMPING

The above-named defendant on or about Wednesday, March 13, 2024, in the City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin, having been charged with a felony in Brown County Case 2019CF969 and having been released from custody under Chapter 969 Wis. Stats., did intentionally fail to comply with the terms of his bond, contrary to sec. 946.49(1)(b) Wis. Stats., a Class H Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than six (6) years, or both.

Complainant is an Assistant District Attorney with the Brown County District Attorney's Office and knows of the above offense on information and belief based upon:

PROBABLE CAUSE

1. Your complainant's review of the Brown County District Attorney's Office case notes and the records of the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access Program (CCAP) website, which records are believed to be truthful and reliable as they are records kept in the ordinary course of departmental business. Said records reflect that in Brown County Case 2019CF969, on or about July 9, 2019, Franklin Ortiz, dob: 08/22/2001, the defendant, made an initial appearance in Brown County Court on felony charges of Conspiracy to Commit Delivery of Heroin (>50g) and Conspiracy to Commit Delivery of THC (>10,000g). At that time, Court Commissioner Resar imposed a \$25,000 cash bond, which included a condition that the defendant must report to CJS within 24 hours of court or release from custody.

On May 4, 2020, Judge Hinkfuss amended the cash bond to a \$5,000 cash bond with the same conditions as imposed by Commissioner Resar.

CCAP records show that on May 4, 2020, the \$5,000 cash bond was posted on the defendant's behalf.

2. On May 12, 2020, your complainant received a report from CJS which indicates that "On 6/18/2019, in Brown County Case 2019CF969, Franklin Ortiz was ordered to report to and comply with Criminal Justice Services upon release. According to jail records, he has released from custody on 5/4/2020. As of 5/12/202, Mr. Ortiz has not reported to Criminal Justice Services."

3. On November 2, 2021, your complainant received a report from CJS which indicates that "On 10/15/2021 and 10/29/2021, Franklin Ortiz failed to contact CJS for his scheduled check-ins. Franklin was reminded of these scheduled check-ins on 10/13/2021, 10/15/2021, 10/20/2021, 10/27/2021, and 10/29/2021 via text message and email. Franklin Ortiz contacted CJS on 10/25/2021 about the missed check-in on 10/15/2021 and was informed of his upcoming check-in on 10/29/2021. As of this report, Franklin Ortiz has failed to contact CJS regarding his missed check-in on 10/29/2021.CJS supervision of Franklin Ortiz has been suspended and will resume when they re-establish compliance with our program."

4. On May 11, 2022, your complainant received a report from CJS which indicates that "On 04/11/2022, 04/25/2022, and 05/09/2022, Franklin Ortiz failed to contact CJS for his scheduled check-ins. Franklin was reminded of these scheduled check-ins on 04/09/2022, 04/11/2022, 04/12/2022, 04/23/2022, 04/25/2022, 04/26/2022, 05/07/2022, 05/09/2022 and 05/11/2022 via text message and email. As of this report, Franklin Ortiz has failed to contact CJS regarding his missed check-ins. CJS supervision of Franklin Ortiz has been suspended and will resume when they re-establish compliance with our program."

5. On September 28, 2022, your complainant received a report from CJS which indicates that "On 8/29/2022, 09/12/2022, and 09/26/2022, Franklin Ortiz failed to contact CJS for his scheduled check-ins. Franklin was reminded of these scheduled check-ins on 08/27/2022, 08/29/2022, 08/31/2022, 09/10/2022, 09/12/2022, 09/13/2022, 09/24/2022, 09/26/2022, and 09/27/2022 via text message and email. As of this report, Franklin Ortiz has failed to contact CJS regarding his missed check-ins. Per VineLink, Franklin Ortiz does not appear to be in custody elsewhere. CJS supervision of Franklin Ortiz has been suspended and will resume when they re-establish compliance with our program. Franklin Ortiz is scheduled for his next check in with CJS on 10/10/2022."

6. On October 24, 2023, your complainant received a report from CJS which indicates that "On 9/22/2023 and 10/22/2023 Franklin Ortiz failed to contact Criminal Justice Services (CJS) for their scheduled check-ins. It is confirmed that Franklin Ortiz received reminders of these appointments on 9/20/2023, 9/22/2023, 10/20/2023, and 10/22/2023 via text message and email. CJS supervision of Franklin Ortiz has been suspended and will resume when Franklin Ortiz re-establishes compliance with our program."

7. On March 13, 2024, your complainant received a report from CJS which indicates that "On 06/18/29, Franklin Ortiz was ordered to report and comply with Criminal Justice Servies (CJS). Frankling Ortiz has failed to report to CJS since 09/22/23. Multiple attempts since 09/22/23 to make contact with Franklin Ortiz has been unsuccessful. CJS supervision of Franklin Ortiz has been suspended and will resume when Franklin Ortiz re-establishes compliance with our program."

8. The complainant has also reviewed the records of the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access Program which she has used in the past and found to be reliable which indicate that on or about July 9, 2019 the defendant was charged with Conspiracy to Manufacture/Deliver Heroin and Conspiracy to Manufacture/Deliver THC in Brown County Case 19CF969 and allowed to be released on bond with a condition that he commit no new crimes. Said bond and its conditions were in effect on said date.

Based on the foregoing, the complainant believes this complaint to be true and correct.
