Ms. Halla-Valdes requests the court make findings for exceptional reasons under 18 U.S.C. § 3145(c) due to the medical situation of Mr. Peterson. Mr. Peterson has been compliant with all conditions of release. Mr. Humble does not object considering the medical condition. The court finds exceptional reasons not to impose the mandatory custody requirement due to the additional need for medical and surgical treatment. The conditions of supervision remain in effect.
