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Narrative of Events (WOLLNER, D. J.) Submitted by WOLLNER, D. J.(4/24/2025 2:18:03 AM)

INITIAL CONTACT

On Thursday, April 24, 2025 at approximately 12:55 AM I, Deputy D. Wollner #1368 was working patrol for the Brown County Sheriff 's Office. I noted that dispatch had created a 911 assist call for CTH RK and Riverdale Dr (Village of Hobart, Brown County, WI). Notes indicated that dispatch received a severe car crash notification from Brandon Stevens and spoke with the individual who advised that he had dropped his phone and there was no emergency. Dispatch then closed the call.

I responded to the area to check for any signs of a crash. Upon arrival at approximately 1:07 AM, I observed a dark color SUV on the west side of the highway fence west of the intersection of CTH RK and Riverdale Dr. As I approached, I could see the vehicle brake lights activate along with the reverse lights. A male party got out of the driver seat who was later identified as Brandon L. Yollowbird Stevens. Brandon stated he was not injured and was the only person in the vehicle.

While speaking with Brandon I noted that he had slow slurred speech and could smell an odor of alcohol coming from him. Brandon stated that he had approximately 5-6 drinks over a six hour period.

Brandon indicated that he was westbound on CTH RK and accidentally hit the accelerator instead of the brake pedal as he navigated the roundabout. Tire skid marks were observed in the center area of the roundabout with one skid mark hiding the curb and one on the paved portion. On the west side of the roundabout tracks went through the grass, gouged out dirt and grass on the west side of the sidewalk and the highway fence was bent leaning over suggesting the vehicle went over the fence. Additionally there were car parts leading up to the fence that matched the suspect vehicle.

Deputy J. Kazik #1318 arrived on scene and Brandon was turned over to him to continue investigation into possible operating while intoxicated. I stood by and provided scene security while field sobriety tests were administered. Following the field sobriety tests, Deputy Kazik advised Brandon would be under arrest for operating while intoxicated and I assisted securing Brandon in handcuffs.

The crash investigation was turned over to Officer C. Tremel #506 from Hobart-Lawrence Police Department. Brandon 's vehicle was removed by Heavy Duty Towing.

Squad car and body worn camera video from the incident is retained on Brown County Sheriff 's Office Axon program.

Nothing further to report at this time.

OWI INVESTIGATION

On Thursday April 24, 2025 at approx. 1:07 AM, I, Deputy Kazik was working an OWI enforcement task force operating a marked squad with internal light package and in full duty uniform when I overheard Deputy Wollner (#1368) call out via radio that he was out with a crashed vehicle near the intersection of CTH RK and Riverdale Dr in the Village of Hobart (Brown County, WI). A short time later, Deputy Wollner advised the driver of the vehicle was possibly under the influence and requested a task force squad. I responded to the scene.

Upon arrival, I met with Deputy Wollner where I was advised that prior to him checking this area, there was a 911 assist for a severe crash notification in the area. He had noticed this call via CAD and proceeded to the area before it had been closed out. He advised he located the vehicle just west of the T roundabout intersection, near some woods and tall grass. He made contact with the driver, identified as Brandon L Yellowbird-Stevens via his identification card. Brandon had been traveling west on CTH RK when he failed to maintain control of his vehicle and entered the wooded, grassy area just off the roadway. Brandon was operating a black Land Rover bearing Tribal plates Brandon emanated an odor of alcohol from his breath and admitted to consuming alcohol. I was advised Brandon was seated in the back seat of Deputy Wollner's squad. I proceeded to make contact with him.

I open the door and identified myself to Brandon. I detected the odor of alcohol emanate from Brandon when I spoke with him. Brandon exhibited thick tongued, slurred speech and glassy, bloodshot eyes. Brandon advised he was at a food tasting event related to the NFL Draft that was being hosted in Green Bay, WI. He had advised he had two drinks while at the tasting. He proceeded to have a few more alcoholic beverages while at the Epic Event Center prior to driving home. Brandon advised that when he was maneuvering his vehicle, he hit the gas pedal when he meant to hit the brake pedal, causing him to increase speed and travel off the roadway. Brandon informed me that he had not taken any prescription or illicit drug. I asked him to exit the squad and I escorted him to a location in front of my squad.

I briefly spoke with HLPD Officer C. Trembl (#506), it was agreed I proceed with the OWI investigation and he would investigate the crash. Brandon agreed to perform Standard Field Sobriety Test's (SFST's). I confirmed with Brandon that he was not injured and he did not seek medical assistance. Brandon advised he had no medical concerns that would hinder his performance. The tests were performed on a flat, level surface, clear of debris, and with little to no wind. A pat down was performed due to our close proximity where no evidentiary items were located.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

Brandon advised he understood the test. The stimulus used was my right index finger. Brandon advised he could see the stimulus. I observed equal pupil size, no resting nystagmus, and equal tracking in both eyes.

I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes (2). I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes (2). I observed nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes (2). 6 of 6 clues

Vertical Gaze Nystagmus:

Present, which indicates a high dose of alcohol and/or drug for that individual.

Walk and Turn:

Brandon advised he understood how to obtain the instructional stance and was prompted to move into it. At first, Brandon had a slight issue of left and right but was able to work it out. I provided instruction and demonstrated the rest of the test for



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Brandon. Brandon advised he understood. On the first set of nine steps, Brandon missed heel to toe by more than a half inch (1), took 10 steps (1) and stopped performing the test (1). He did not perform the turn as instructed, pivoting in one motion (1). On the second set of nine steps, Brandon stepped off line (1), missed heel to toe, and took 11 steps. 5 of 8 clues

One Leg Stand:

Brandon advised he understood the test. Brandon chose to raise his left foot. Brandon placed his foot down (1). Brandon exhibited a two inch side to side sway to remain balanced (1), and raised arms more than six inches to remain balanced (1). 3 of 4 clues

It was my opinion that Brandon was under the influence of alcohol and was unable to operate a motor vehicle safely. Based on Brandon causing a single vehicle crash by failing to maintain control of his vehicle, observations upon initial contact, his performance during the SFST's, his admittance to consuming alcohol and my detection of an odor of alcohol, I concluded to place Brandon under arrest for OWI. Brandon agreed to provide a breath sample for a PBT to corroborate the clues I observed are due to alcohol impairment. The result of the PBT was .19 BrAC. I informed Brandon he was under arrest for OWI 1st Offence. I placed one set of handcuffs onto his wrists, checking fit, and double locking them. Brandon was escorted to my squad where he was placed in the back seat.

I completed two traffic citations for OWI 1st Offense and Fail to Maintain Control of Vehicle to Brandon. I read aloud and verbatim, the entirety of the Informing the Accused to Brandon. He stated "Yes" to an evidentiary chemical test of his blood. I proceeded to transport Brandon to St. Mary's Hospital for legal blood.

I opened and inspected the contents of a WI State Lab of Hygiene blood kit (EXP: 07/31/2026). Medical Technician Patricia Welch of St. Mary's entered the room and drew two vials of blood from Brandon's right arm in my presence. The two vials were turned over to me as evidence. The vials were secured and packaged into the kit. I sealed the kit which I initialed and dated. The kit stayed in my presence and control until I logged it into the BCSO temporary evidence refrigerator. I read Brandon his Miranda Rights. Brandon advised he understood his rights, chose to waive them and answer questions. I proceeded to escort him to his responsible party identified as Ashlee E. Olujic . I read to both the Responsible Party Form. Ashlee signed the form and both were provided their respective copies. Brandon was released to Ashlee. I left the hospital shortly after.

Incident captured on AXON BWC and in squad camera and retained on evidence.com. All paperwork was scanned into the attachments tab. Brandon was cooperative throughout the entire incident.
